Dear Mr. Morales Carrión:

This is just a word to supplement my recent telephone conversation with Governor Muñoz Marín. I want you to know that we intend to recommend your name as an alternate delegate to the forthcoming Tenth Inter-American Conference at Caracas, and I feel confident that the President will accept this recommendation. We hope that you will handle cultural matters for us at the Conference.

Secretary Dulles and Under Secretary Smith will head the Conference alternately. Among the other alternate delegates we expect to have Ambassadors Dreier and Bohan, Mr. William Sanders, now Counselor of Embassy in Santiago, Chile, and General Edgerton, head of the Export-Import Bank.

I do hope that you will be able to be with us there. Please let us know if there are any difficulties from your viewpoint.
