Conversación telefónica con el Secretario EWH - Rubicoff - 1:30 PM

LMM- Dr. Arturo Morales Carrión, now Under Secretary of State for the Commonwealth but soon Deputy Assistant Secretary in Washington I do not know who in the Federal Government he is in touch with, inquired about 100-150 school teachers that can be employed in Puerto Rico. I had news this morning. Everying is ~~XXXX~~ arranged to be able to receive that number of teachers. We have some professors at the University, but there could be place to accomadate some more, not very much in number. He communicated with one of my aides this morning and this is the news, except that do not want to make them public for some reason. What he was told was that they want to announce it from here, or from the State Dept., something like that. We have unemployment there but we always have employment for school teachers.
