Dear Arturo:


Our mutual friend, Arturo Torres-Rioseco, has told me of his correspondence with you concerning the extension of your forthcoming trip to Colorado to include a visit on our Campus April 13 and 14. I write as Chairman of our Center for Latin American Studies, a research-oriented group of Latin Americanists on the faculty, to extend our welcome to you and to help in organizing a profitable schedule while you are here.

Professor Torres informs me that you would be willing to give a public lecture and to meet less formally with smaller groups while you are here. I have consulted with our Committee on Drama, Lectures and Music about the lecture and would like to propose that under the joint sponsorship of that Committee and the Latin American Center you give a lecture on a subject of your choice (any aspect you might choose of Puerto Rican development would be of wide interest, I am sure), perhaps in the later afternoon of April 14. We hope you would also be willing to meet less formally with members of the Center to make such remarks as you wish and to discuss with them matters of mutual interest. I believe the evening of April 13 might be best from the standpoint of making it possible for a maximum turn-out of faculty Latin Americanists to be present. Perhaps Professor Torres or others might hope to lure you to their individual seminars, but that could be arranged after you arrive.

The Center will be able to make available a modest honorarium of \$100 to help defray your travel and living expenses while here.

I should greatly appreciate your letting me know if the arrangements suggested above are satisfactory to you, at your earliest convenience. Do please let me know as soon as you can the subject of your lecture,\* and if you would like me to announce a particular theme for your informal meeting with the Center members. It will be a very great pleasure to see you again after so long a time.
