Meeting with Nelson Rockefeller: agenda

- 1) Inquire re importance of Governors' conference on Monday concerning "top secret briefing."
- 2) Express desire to see President and Raab, at White House
- 3) Dynamic growth of Commonwealth idea:
 - Refer to Kansas City speech
 - First phase has been successful.
 - Second phase: make commonwealth relationship even more useful to P.R. and U.S.
 - Needs: (1) to dispel differences of opinion between "meagerists" and commonwealth supporters. A frank reexamination of basic differences is in order
 - (2) to revise compact to make it more responsive to principle of mutual consent. ^{Limitations} ~~Contradictions~~ of generic consent as pointed out in K.C. speech.
 - (3) to study ways of increasing P.R.'s participation and usefulness in foreign affairs. Advantages: whenever P.R. participates on its own, in fields within scope of its self-governing powers, not involving political decisions, relationship between U.S. and P.R. is made clearer to rest of Latin America and world. Shows U.S. understanding ^{of complex cultural} ~~and respect for a~~ problem. ^{Admits to U.S. greatness} ~~Adds dimension of greatness~~ ~~to U.S. cause~~ ⁱⁿ before eyes of underdeveloped countries. Answer to charges of colonialism or imperialism. (United States Information Agency heavily

aware of this usefulness, Rockefeller may ask Streibert)

→ Reference to technical assistance programs. Nearly 2,000 trainees from 84 countries in 4 years. Increasing interest in P.R. programs shown by Asiatic and Latin American governments.

BASIC Suggestion

- President may appoint informal committee of Rockefeller, Milton Eisenhower, Nixon to meet with Governor for 2 or 3 days to examine:

- different interpretations

- ~~promise~~ revision of compact

- P.R.'s ^{increased} participation in foreign affairs thru: accession to non-political treaties, specialized international organizations, special technical assistance programs.

Sec. Dulles

- ~~State Dept~~ may appoint top policy-making group of Holland, McK. Kee or even Hoover, if possible, to discuss with Governor, Dr. Ferrus and advisors:

1. Puerto Rico: good answer to charges ^{of U.S.} colonialism and imperialism in Asia and Latin America.
 - Commonwealth relationship as evidence of ~~U.S. fairness~~ and U.S. respect for self-determination
2. Puerto Rico deeply desires to maximize this usefulness, particularly after BANBUING CONFERENCE has demonstrated united Afro-Asiatic opinion against colonialism:
 - Ways:
 - ① training ground for technical assistance programs 2000 trainees from 84 countries. P.R. eager to increase share.
 - ② CARIBBEAN Comm: Pub. urging reform: Representative body with participation on equal basis, Metropolitan powers may or may not participate. On MAY TENTH, ~~the~~ meeting of West Indian Conference: U.S. should avoid impression of colonialism. Suggest: Governor's speech may insinuate joint P.R. + U.S. position as in UNITED NATIONS.
 - ③ Convenience for U.S. to increased P.R.ican participation in international affairs, in non-political field, thru accession to treaties and specialized intl. organizations
