I am sending you a copy of material which I have just received from George Fields, Executive Secretary of Freedom House, following a telephone conversation with him.

Mr. Fields letter to me is self-explanatory and I told him that I would like to have your views as well as our own and would pass on our suggestions no later than Monday, August 27.

It is also important for someone to know what Walter Lippman will say so that the Governor's own talk will fit into the program. Lippman will be asked to speak for about ten minutes and Governor Muñoz for about fourteen minutes, to accommodate radio programming. Mr. Fields feels that Lippman should discuss the accomplishments of Governor Muñoz and Puerto Rico, while Governor Muñoz should discuss point four in terms of Puerto Rico and against the background of the Freedom Story.

Please let me have your comments by Monday.
