I stated that this question had been discussed several times in the past in the General Assembly and in the Fourth Committee and that decisions had been taken on it. On the most recent occasion, the General Committee decided not to put the question of Fuerto Rico on the agenda of the General Assembly, and that decision was confirmed by the Ceneral Assembly. By delegation was one of the delegations that supported that decision of the General Assembly.
