Dear Candidate:

You were required by law, as a certified candidate for Representative to the 93rd Congress, to file pre-election and periodic reports. (See p. 11 -- Sec. 304(a), Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 -- copy enclosed.)

According to the public records on file with the Clerk of the U. S. House of Representatives, you have failed to comply with the law. The criminal penalties for non-compliance of this law include imprisonment for not more than one year or a \$1,000 fine or both.

You are strongly urged to fill out the enclosed H.R. Election Form 2 and to mail same in the enclosed self-addressed envelope immediately.

The Special Committee to Investigate Campaign Expenditures for the House of Representatives, 1972, has voted unanimously to send you this final notice by certified mail, return receipt requested. Upon your failure to respond within ten days of the date on this notice, your name will be forwarded to the Attorney General of the United States for appropriate action.
