
Dear Sir:

With reference to your letter of August 7 on my campaign expenditures, I called yesterday your office and talked to Mr. Frank Butler. On July 31, I wrote Mr. Jennings a letter, a copy of which is attached, and on the next day my attorney sent the notarized report on my campaign expenditures.
