Section 303 of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 (P.L. 92-225) requires "...each political committee which anticipates receiving contributions or making expenditures during the calendar year in an aggregate amount exceeding \$1,000 shall file with the supervisory officer a statement of organization, within ten days after its organization or, if later, ten days after the date on which it has information which causes the committee to anticipate it will receive contributions or make expenditures in excess of \$1,000..." Since you have been filing with the Clerk of the House Reports of Receipts and Expenditures for a Committee (H.R. Election Form 3), it appears that as a political committee you have the reciprocal statutory obligation to file the prescribed Registration Form and Statement of Organization (H.R. Election Form 1).

Section 308(a) (12) of the Act charges the Clerk of the House, as Supervisory Officer, "to report apparent violations of law to the appropriate law enforcement authorities." Section 311 of the Act prescribes that any person who violates these provisions "...shall be fined not more than \$1,000.00, imprisoned not more than one year, or both." I am herewith notifying you that the Clerk of the House has not yet received a Registration Form and Statement of Organization (H.R. Election Form 1) from your political committee.

For your convenience, copies of H.R. Election Form 1, a copy of the Act, and of the Clerk's Manual of Regulations and Accounting Instructions are enclosed. The completed and notarized form should be filed promptly, together with any explanation of this matter you may desire to submit.
