Board of Trustees Evaluations

Fifteen members of the twenty six members of the Board have replied to requests for evaluations.

San Germán Friends of IAU

The steering committee met October 3 and reviewed the compilation of the evaluations. Senator Santiago R. Palmer was selected unanimously as chairman of the San Germán Friends of IAU Committee. Senator Palmer enlisted all the steering committee members present and will enlist one more man for a total committee of eight.

Discussion concerned organization, goal and method of solicitation. The seven committee members under the chairman will act as team captains and each enlist five team members or solicitors.

The next meeting is scheduled for October 17 to select team members, submit pledges of the committee and set a goal for San Germán.

President's Council

The President's Council now has 37 members, 10 have declined and two are pending. Follow-up is to be made on twenty more candidates and a list of fifteen additional names will be submitted to the Planning and Development Committee.

Corporations

Mr. Madera of IAU and Mr. Wasson of Tamlyn & Brown met with Mr. Ramón Calderón, Executive Director of the Industrial Association of Puerto Rico. Mr. Calderón accepted membership in the President's Council and agreed to 1) help compile lists of U.S. and insular firms not assisted by Fomento; 2) enlist several corporation executives to aid in evaluation; 3) provide publicity services via the Industrial Association's publications; 4) help evaluate alumni lists.
