Board of Trustees

Tamblin and Brown reported on organizational and research progress to date to the Board of Trustees on October 15.

The Board adopted \$500,000 and a 100% participation as a working goal. January 29 was set as tentative date for obtaining all Board pledges.

Messrs Findley, Ingalls, Otto, and Robinson were appointed as the Stateside Board solicitation committee and met October 26 in New York to assign prospects and review solicitation methods.

Dr. Rodríguez Quiñones and Messrs Beverley, Russell and Zalduondo compose the solicitation committee for Puerto Rico Board members and will meet November 1.

San Germán Friends of IAU

The San Germán Friends of Inter American University have adopted \$100,00 as a working goal. Initial solicitation of the eight man committee is underway.

President's Council

Thirty eight individuals have accepted membership in the President's Council. Mr. Luis Ferré, Ponce industrialist, has agreed to chair the Steering Committee of the President's Council to meet November 4 in San Juan. The Steering Committee will present recommendations for Committee organizations and membership to a full Council meeting scheduled for December 6 in San Juan.

Foundations

Mr. Witter has prepared a general file of Foundations with probable interest in the Inter American University Development Program. A list of some forty foundations was given to attending members of the Board of Trustees in the meeting of October 15 for evaluation and comment. These are to be returned in the immediate future. Approach to Foundations is now dependent upon information from the Board of Trustees and, most important, the printing of the annual report of the University. As soon as figures are available from the Business Office on financial data, the annual report can be processed.
