Campaign Organization

Sam H. Casey, president of Commonwealth Oil Refining Company, has accepted the general chairmanship of the Inter American University Development Program. Mr. Casey made a formal announcement of his acceptance at the meeting of the President's Council, Tuesday, December 6th in San Juan. At the time Mr. Casey emphasized that the President's Council was not a fund raising organization, however he will personally be calling upon the services of a number of the members and support from their institutions. His announcement was greeted with enthusiasm by all present. Mr. Casey will now begin to recruit his top leadership, primarily, the Honorary Chairmen, the Vice Chairman and the Chairman for the corporation and business committee.

President's Council

The President's Council held its first organizational meeting at the San Gerónimo Hilton in San Juan on December 6th. Temporary presidency was accepted by Pedro Purcell and various other committee chairmen accepted nominations as had been recommended by the steering committee. Dr. Hoxeng, Don Luis Ferré, Dr. Herron and Mr. Purcell fully outlined the duties of the President's Council and the various committees and asked that the working committees begin operations in the near future. The first annual meeting and formal election of officers is being planned for May 1967. Out of the forty nine members of the President's Council thirty one were present and nine sent apologies for absence.

Publicity

Mr. Casey's acceptance of the Campaign chairmanship was formally announced in Puerto Rico's San Juan Star, Monday, December 12 and in the other newspapers shortly thereafter. The Publicity Department of Commonwealth Oil Refining Company has agreed to work closely with the Development Fund organization in obtaining publicity in the United States. They have agreed to cover the major newspapers on the Eastern seaboard, particularly the cities of Washington, New York, Philadelphia, Pittsburgh, Chicago and Detroit. Tamlyn & Brown will release to the wire services for upstate New York and will handle relations with Presbyterian publications.
