Campaign Organization

Mr. Sam Casey, Chairman of the Development Fund, and Dr. Hoxeng met with Mr. Francisco de Jesús, Vice-President of the Chase Manhattan Bank Monday, December 12. Present were Mr. Sol Descartes of the Board of Trustees, Mr. Victor Madera, Secretary of the President's Council and Mr. Wayne Wasson. After a thorough discussion of the Development Program by Dr. Hoxeng, Mr. Casey requested Mr. de Jesús to take the position of Vice Chairman of the Development Fund for Puerto Rico. Mr. de Jesús requested time to consider the matter. Also discussed were possible candidates for honorary treasurer for the campaign organization. Mr. Casey and Mr. de Jesús were furnished with lists of top companies and their managers on the island for consideration of chairman of the business and corporation committee of Puerto Rico and the key committee members. Also discussed were candidates for honorary chairman for Puerto Rico. One possible candidate has been decided upon and is to be approached by Dr. Hoxeng.

Campaign Materials

A copy of Dun & Bradstreet for Puerto Rico has been obtained and is being broken down listing all companies and their owners with assets of \$100,000 and rating of three or more for every town in Puerto Rico. This will be cross-indexed with the existing lists of manufacturers and businesses. In the case of smaller towns members from these lists will be possible candidates for steering and/or solicitation committees for their particular areas.

Board of Trustees - Puerto Rico

Five members of the Board of Trustees of Puerto Rico have pledged \$11,000 with cash payments amounting to \$1200. There are still ten Board members and former Board members to be solicited. Another report from the solicitation committee is expected the first week in January.

Mr. Wasson met with Mr. Gardner Russell concerning the Muna Lee Memorial. Mr. Russell is contacting Mr. Arturo Morales Carrión in Washington to ask him to begin a list of Muna Lee's friends there. Meanwhile Mr. Russell is doing the same here in Puerto Rico.
