Texas-born J. Will Harris travelled to Puerto Rico in 1906 as a Presbyterian missionary. Within six years he founded, in San Germán, a school which graduated its first high school class in 1916 and first college class in 1927. This school has become Inter American University of Puerto Rico <sup>which</sup> ~~and~~ now enrolls over in 15 locations. 26,000 students. Dr. Harris's story is the spiritual autobiography of a fascinating man, a record of life in rural Puerto Rico in the early years of this century, and an account by a gifted educator of the emergence and growth of a private institution of higher education in a developing nation.
