Texas-born J. Will Harris travelled to Puerto Rico in 1906 as a Presbyterian missionary. Within six years he founded, in San Germán, a school which graduated its first high school class in 1916 and first college class in 1927. This school has become Inter American University of Puerto Rico and now enrolls over in 15 locations.)
